


We are one of the leading building solutions companies in the country and have operated in the Philippines for over five decades

- We are one of the 50 biggest companies and taxpayers in the Philippines operating cement manufacturing facilities in La Union, Bulacan, Batangas, Misamis Oriental and Davao with a combined annual production capacity of 10 million metric tons. Our company also produces dry mix products and has an aggregates business.

We are committed to operating more sustainably to have a more positive impact on society

- Our company has developed a Sustainable Development roadmap that are designed to contribute to 14 of the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. By 2030, we are committed to the following:
 - lower carbon emissions by 40% and water consumption by 30%
 - use more qualified wastes in producing cement (600,000 tons from 2015 to 2018)
 - continue programs to help improve lives of people in our communities (600,000 individuals, from 2015 to 2018)

- Our corporate citizenship programs under Holcim Helps are focused on education, livelihood and infrastructure to enable beneficiaries to take the lead in improving their lives
- We also advocate sustainability among future builders to inspire them that they can have a more positive impact by balancing economic objectives environmental and social responsibility





These initiatives include our participation in multisectoral initiatives to provide shelters that help communities pursue better lives

- In 2014, Holcim worked with the Compostela Valley government and the Green Architecture Advocacy Philippines to provide new houses for 150 families who survived Typhoon Pablo
- In 2016, our company again joined DSWD Region XI and the Davao City government in relocating to safer homes 129 families living near our plant







We are using the same collaborative approach in helping rebuild a community impacted by conflict













We will help equip the beneficiaries with skills to rebuild their homes and enable them to participate in the building boom

- The new skills enable them to participate in the strong building activity in their communities and beyond given the strong demand for skilled construction workers
- Our masonry training program has produced close to 10,000 certified skilled construction workers who are helping build quality structures for the country and have improved employment opportunities that can help them have their homes
